



Water island Search and Rescue Tsunami evacuation plan:

**REMEMBER: IF THERE IS AN EARTHQUAKE LASTING MORE THAN 2 MINUTES OR SHAKING VIOLENTLY TO WHERE YOU CANNOT STAND- THEN A TSUNAMI IS LIKELY TO FOLLOW- IF YOU ARE BELOW THE MINIMUM SAFE ELEVATION WE SUGGEST YOU MOVE TO THE LANDMARK MEETING POINT IN YOUR ZONE AS SOON AS YOU ARE SAFELY ABLE (WHEN THE SHAKING STOPS) DO NOT WAIT FOR EMERGENCY SIRENS OR WARNINGS. GET YOUR SURVIVAL ITEMS AND GO.**

In the event of an imminent Tsunami WISAR has implemented the following plan:

there are 4 zones on water island with the high points marked at a land mark.

if you are in your home and it is above 80ft (25m) in elevation then you should be safe to stay in your home.  
if you are below that recommended minimum height then you should proceed to the land mark meeting point for your zone- see above map.

Zone 1 - Fort Segara elevation 206'

Zone 2 - Catchment Hill Elevation 160'

Zone 3 - Tower House Elevation 242'

Zone 4 - Sprat Bay upper Gate Elevation 278'

The land mark meeting zones shall be a place for all persons in that zone to meet and put together a plan for the after math of the event and to use as marking points for communications with other zones and st thomas- so that we can give the "All Clear" and return to our homes or a safe place if destruction has occurred to property.

The first person on the scene of the meeting point shall set up a command post and shall be responsible for trying to establish communications with the other zones and also st thomas and to report any information regarding their zone so that a clear plan of action can be followed to get help to those in need and to set up a base camp, collect supplies needed and make interim housing.
